AM I ELIGIBLE?

You meet credit score requirements.

- Conventional, USDA, and VA Loans: 640 or higher
- → FHA Loans: 650 or higher

You meet debt to income ratios for your loan type.

- You meet income and purchase price limits.*
 - You work in one of the following careers in public service:
 - → U.S. Veterans, active duty military or member of reserve components (includes a surviving (esuoga
 - Police officers, firefighters, volunteer firefighters, EMTs or paramedics
 - Physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses (RN and LPN) and STNAs
 - Teachers in pre-K through grade 12, administrators and counselors
